CARE

Assistance Publique-Hôpitaux de Paris (AP-HP) 's 38 hospitals welcome nearly 8 million patients every year for consultations, hospitalizations, and hospital-at-home at every stage of life. AP-HP takes care of everyone in need of medical assistance.

FOCUS ON THE PATIENT

AP-HP provides excellent patient care. It structures care pathways before and after hospitalizations, ensuring uninterrupted care. And it offers treatment based on the most innovative technologies and equipment.

With its 345 therapeutic education programs, AP-HP allows patients to play an active role in their own treatment. Patients and their families help improve AP-HP hospitals by participating in meetings and activities organized by the 250 associations present.

AN ACADEMIC MEDICAL CENTER WITH CLOSE TIES TO ITS REGION

AP-HP has developed close ties with the local medical community to ensure smoother patient care and mixed practice for hospital physicians.

In addition to its long-standing cooperations with health centers and nursing homes, AP-HP has also forged ties with 45 territorial health professional communities (CPTS), covering around 60 projects.

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TRAINING

As the university hospital center for the Paris region, AP-HP trains the health-care professionals of today and tomorrow. Its challenge: to acquire and rely on the best-trained caregivers who provide top-tier care.

A REPUTABLE TEACHING FACILITY

Every year, AP-HP welcomes:

- nearly 8,700 nursing students and specialized nurses (anesthesia, surgery, childcare), nursing aids, childcare assistants, medical electroradiology technicians, hospital pharmacy technicians, physiotherapists, midwives, medical regulation assistants, health staff managers;
- 7,500 students in medicine, dentistry and pharmacy;
- 4,600 interns.

AP-HP's training sites are located in the heart of Paris and in its suburbs, and are backed by AP-HP, Europe's largest university hospital group. AP-HP has signed agreements with the seven universities in the Paris region.

CAREER ADVANCEMENT

AS A PRIORITY

AP-HP pursues an active career advancement policy. It covers training costs and remuneration for its committed professionals. For in-demand jobs, AP-HP provides additional support: when an employee's



application is approved by their designated site, and registered on the entrance exam list, their funding is automatically secured, regardless of quotas.

AP-HP has five continuing education centers. This is a major asset in an ever-changing hospital environment where attracting and retaining qualified professionals is a complex challenge.

RESEARCH & INNOVATION

Through its publications, awards, and advancements in the medical field, AP-HP is a leading force in research.

AT THE FOREFRONT OF CLINICAL

RESEARCH IN FRANCE

Research at AP-HP is constantly improving care and developing new treatments. Any patient can benefit from the most innovative therapies by taking part in a clinical trial. In France, half of all clinical research is carried out in AP-HP hospitals.

At the heart of a network of partners, AP-HP is the first university hospital in France to be awarded the Institut Carnot label in recognition of the quality of its research partnerships.

The AP-HP clinical data warehouse (EDS) is the largest in Europe. It collects data from over 14 million patients with absolute respect for the confidentiality of personal information. The EDS has been authorized by the French Data Protection Authority (CNIL) since 2017.

MEDICAL INNOVATION ANCHORED

IN CARE

For patients, AP-HP builds bridges between primary and clinical research. It holds a portfolio of 810 active patents covering biotechnologies, diagnostics, biomaterials, medical devices, medications, genetics, as well as cell and gene therapies, and more.

@HÔTEL-DIEU

The @Hôtel-Dieu initiative, launched by AP-HP and Université Paris Cité in 2021, aims to anchor innovation in care by opening the doors of Paris's oldest hospital to innovators.

A SUSTAINABLE AND

ECO-RESPONSIBLE HOSPITAL

For AP-HP, reducing its environmental footprint and greenhouse gas emissions is an institutional and civic duty. It is also a condition for the sustainability of care activities over the long term.

As a major player in the healthcare sector, AP-HP sets an example for many other establishments. It must also set an example in its ecological transition. Decarbonization processes have been launched in each of its establishments, and carbon quantification tools have been developed, such as Carebone®, which estimates the greenhouse gas emissions of patient care pathways.

AP-HP is also the birthplace of Plan Health Faire®, an educational workshop designed to help people understand the challenges of ecological transitions in healthcare. All AP-HP directors are trained.

EXPERIENCE AND EXPERTISE SHARED

INTERNATIONALLY

AP-HP develops robust international activity: scientific and research collaborations, hospital partnerships with developing or emerging countries, exchanges of healthcare professionals, care of non-resident patients

(uninsured), and equipment donations. 70 partnerships are active today.

A FOUNDATION FOR THE HEALTH OF ALL

The AP-HP Foundation works alongside patients, caregivers and researchers at the 38 AP-HP hospitals to support health for all.

Launched in 2016, its purpose is to support Assistance Publique - Hôpitaux de Paris in its areas of expertise.

Its three main areas of intervention are:


- the medicine of the future, accelerating innovation and supporting research into all diseases, even the rarest;
